We want the T-shirts to display positive messages about breaking barriers, helping others and treating people fairly. You can come up with a slogan that expresses how you feel, or maybe come up with a colourful design.

The winner will have their work printed onto t-shirts, will win £300, a free assembly in their educational or youth setting from high achieving guests and.... will be exhibited at the Southbank Centre during the Unlimited festival!

Talks from high achieving guest speakers will be about their career paths to date in the Arts, Cultural and Creative

Sectors. They aim to encourage and motivate people to think positively about future planning. Speakers will draw appropriately on personal experiences as a disabled person to describe how they overcame challenges and barriers, and maximised the opportunities that comes with fulfilling potential.

Attendees of the festival will be able to vote for their favourite design from the ten, and the overall winner will be announced on September 5th at the festival itself.
