

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



THE CUBE IS...

...a visual representation of the volume of a tonne of carbon dioxide at a pressure of 1 atm and a temperature of 15 °C. It is 8.117m high. It is the result of a project, developed with scientist and artist Dr Adam Nieman to illustrate the scale of the greenhouse gas problem. At the time it was built, Britain emitted a 'Cube' of carbon dioxide every 39 days. The world emitted one every 80 days. It is our 'Fourth Plinth,' a space where things happen.


