





Advisers trained in London














Registered Arts Award centres in London



Registered centres vs active centres in 15/16





Active Arts Award Centres by Borough



Percentage and number of Arts Award centres in London offering moderations between Apr-15 – Mar-16, of 1015 total centres. Source: Trinity










Percentage of centres that delivered to groups of over 50 young people on one date between Apr15-Mar16 (235 centres tot) Source: Trinity




Active centres in London delivering 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 Arts Award levels between Apr-15 – Mar-16 by borough Source: Trinity

2012/13 research on awareness of Arts Award



•Those in **school** (27%) and **college/sixth form** (30%) are more likely to have heard of Arts Award than those at university, those who are in paid employment and those who are NEET

Interest in Arts Award

Those in **school** (69%) **college/sixth form** (59%) and those in **Apprenticeships/Training/ Internships** (68%) are most interested in Arts Award followed by those in university (51%) or paid employment (49%).


Q: "How interested would you be in taking part in Arts Award?"

Glossary

Arts Award – A programme that allows young people aged 5 to 25 to get involved in arts and cultural activities, be inspired and grow as artists and arts leaders. It offers them a chance to develop their creativity, communication and leadership skills and get recognised through a group of national qualifications

Centre - An organisation that is registered to support young people in achieving their Arts Award

Supporter - An organisation or artist offering activities that young people can use towards their Arts Award, such as workshops, arts and cultural events which they can review, opportunities to find out about artists and cultural opportunities, a chance to share skills or lead arts projects

Level - Arts Award has five levels, four of which (Explore, Bronze, Silver and Gold) are accredited qualifications. Arts Award Discover is an introductory award.

Adviser – A trained professional supporting a young person as they are undertaking Arts Award and assessing their achievement

Moderation – Once the young person has completed all tasks related to their Arts Award a trained Arts Award Moderator checks the Adviser's assessment for the accredited levels


