About the role

We are looking for a content creator and social media intern with an interest in digital technology and/or performing arts, and a desire to develop their knowledge of working within a creative organisation.

As industry leaders in the dance and technology sector, our work is multidisciplinary and we are often working on several different projects simultaneously throughout the year. The ideal candidate will be interested in supporting the company across our various projects, including monitoring our social media channels, editing short videos/clips to promote our work online, putting together promotional decks and conducting research into the latest social media/marketing trends.

Our collaborators and core team have specialisms across fields of **creative technology**, **choreography**, **arts education**, **producing**, **marketing**, **graphic design**, **coding** and **animation** to name a few. As part of the 12-month placement with AWDC, you will be assigned **mentorship** from within our core team for regular support and guidance, alongside a series of 1-2-1s, where you will be able to shadow members of our team and collaborators to further develop your desired skill-set.

We are keen to develop the placement around your interests and this position has space to evolve and grow throughout the 12 months, as we encourage you to explore areas that best suit your future goals.

You will report directly to a dedicated staffing team and will be invited to join our online workspace to help you manage your schedule and keep abreast of company activity to inform your work.

As a hybrid organisation, our small team of core-staff work both remotely and from our studio in Hackney Wick. We are open to discussing a work schedule that suits you and any other commitments you might have.

STEP is a training programme for young East Londoners local to the Olympic Park, who are ready to bring ideas, creative energy and perspectives to the creative and cultural sector.

You must be;

- Aged 18 to 30
- Resident of Hackney, Newham, Tower Hamlets and Waltham Forest
- We welcome applicants who have been educated outside of the above boroughs but priority will be given to those that have attended school or college in these boroughs

Through STEP, you'll get paid London Living Wage over a 12-month training programme to develop a range of skills and creative approaches and build on your network across different organisations or departments. You'll complete a work-based placement, grow as part of a peer network, take part in regular professional development workshops, and get a budget to produce a collaborative project. We'll also connect you with a specialist industry mentor, provide careers coaching and continue to offer support as part of our community after the programme.
